Playwork began in adventure playgrounds created around the UK just after the Second World War, and playwork is now used in many different settings around the world.

Discovering Play aims to develop individuals skills to support the facilitation and development of good play environments where children can thrive. Whether this is in the home, school, parks, sports or community settings.
