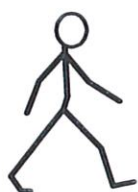


Going to secondary school?



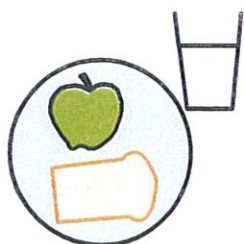

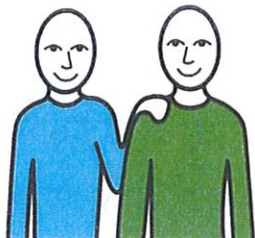
Some students might have extra visits to their new school. The teachers in their new school will take care of them when they visit and when they start school.
